**Pantry:** The head of household must provide their photo identification, as well as some form of identification for each member of their household. All clients requesting assistance will be served.

Each family is eligible to receive a week's supply of food for their household once per month. If household members are all over the age of 60 or disabled, then they are eligible for a week supply of food twice per month once approved by our client service specialists.

**Services:**

**SNAP assistance** – any client that is in need of applying for SNAP or re-certification of their SNAP application.

**Additional Resources** – are available to our clients through our Client Services Specialists. Services such as: rental assistance, financial assistance, veteran and family support services, utility assistance, etc.

**Job Paths** – Heartland Hope invites several businesses that are in high demand of employees to come to our facility and provide employment information for clients. On-site interviews are conducted and help with the application process is provided.

**Financial assistance – at this time Heartland Hope DOES NOT provide any form of financial assistance.**

**Heartland Hope Mission** is providing Thanksgiving pantries. They are currently pre-registering. If families are wanting to pre-register to receive a Thanksgiving pantry, they may do so when they come to our pantry. There will be someone here that will be able to assist them in pre-registering and we are only pre-registering for this month only. Heartland Hope Pantry will be having a Millard pantry 10/14/2017 and pre-registration should be available at that pantry.

### **Costumes**

- Students are asked not to wear their costumes to school. Children should bring their costumes in a bag and label each piece of their costume with their first and last name. Children will be allowed to change before the parade. Parent volunteers and staff will be available to help children change from **2:00-2:15 PM**.
- Makeup that is part of a costume must be applied at home before school. **No makeup will be applied at school.** This includes glittering hair, clown make-up etc. Please have your children wear appropriate makeup that is not too scary.
- The best costumes are those that your child can sit and move in during the party activities.
- Costumes should be age appropriate and not hurt or embarrass fellow students. Please refrain from costumes that are gruesome or having makeup that depicts blood or violence.
- Avoid costumes that are physically revealing. If children are going to wear gymnastic or ballerina costumes, please be sure they also wear tights or a t-shirt to cover midriffs.
- **Anything resembling a weapon, such as a gun, swords, hatchets, etc. will be taken and parents will be called to pick the item up in the office.**
- Costume suggestions: characters from children's literature, athletes, community figures (firefighters, nurses, bakers, etc.)

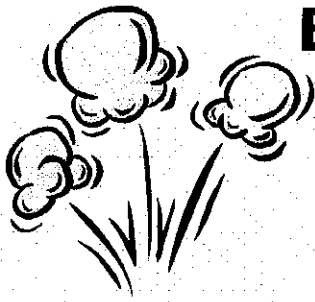

**A couple of reminders for the day of the Halloween Celebration:**

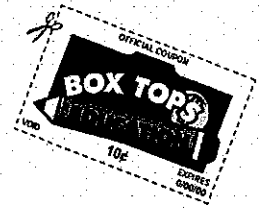
- **PLEASE BRING PHOTO ID and be prepared to present it when you check in.**
