Hello Neihardt Families,

Conferences are quickly approaching! The parent/family sign up on Pick-A-Time, our conference scheduler, closes on Tuesday, October 10th at 11:59PM. Please help us reach our goal to connect 100% of our families with their child's teachers. During conferences teachers will talk with you about your child's strengths and goal areas for the year. This year our K-5 students took the MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) to help guide and individualize planning and instruction. During conferences teacher will share your child's individual results as well as goals they have set as a class (K-2) and individually (3-5).

During conferences, we encourage you to ask your child and your child's teacher about their specific goals and what action steps they plan to take to meet them. Research shows that by including students in the learning process, assessment as one component, it increases student motivation and an overall awareness of their learning. Success in school is built through partnerships between teacher and students -- a collaborative endeavor. We aim to provide a culture in which students are given the respect and responsibility to be meaningfully engaged in their own learning. This year we are asking students to engage with their teachers to set academic goals to become better readers and learners.
